World Around Us

Bridges

- Use Google survey maps to locate bridges in the local and wider area.
- Discuss why bridges are in the places they are.
- Use maps to decide on the best place to put a new bridge in a town. Present reasons for and against this decision.
- Research the history of bridges in NI: The Foyle Bridge, The Peace Bridge and Carrick-a-Rede Rope Bridge.
- Research the history and key facts about famous bridges around the world. Complete a Fact File and present findings to the class.
- Learn of the different types of bridges and the role each bridge has to the community it serves.
- Carry out an investigation on forces and check which bridge can carry a certain weight.
- Complete various science experiments making bridges from different materials. Making predictions, tests and write-ups to accompany each experiment. Make paper bridges and bridges using junk art materials and food.
- Investigate different types of engineering and complete differences and similarities activity about structural and civil engineers.
- Design a bridge using junk art, use models to showcase a design.
